



Climbing Escalade Canada

Policy Code: CEC-ER-03

CEC Event Uniform Code

1. Application

- 1.1 The Climbing Escalade Canada (CEC) Uniform Code applies to all CEC-sanctioned events where athlete participation is determined through Provincial/Territorial Sport Organization (PTSO) qualification pathways. Athletes who receive pre-qualified entry must also be affiliated with a PTSO.
- 1.2 The Uniform Code applies to:
 - 1.2.1 CEC National Championships (Boulder, Lead, Speed)
 - 1.2.2 CEC Youth National Championships (Boulder, Lead, Speed)
 - 1.2.3 CEC Youth Regional Championships (Boulder)

2. Uniform Requirements

- 2.1 Athletes representing a Province or Territory must wear a distinctive team uniform while competing.
- 2.2 The uniform is defined as a Competition Top and must display:
 - 2.2.1 The logo of the Provincial/Territorial Sport Organization or another official provincial/territorial identifier;
 - 2.2.2 A representation of the Provincial or Territorial flag; and
 - 2.2.3 The name of the Province or Territory, or the two-letter code (AB, BC, MB, NB, NL, NU, NT, NS, PE, ON, QC, SK, YT), displayed in a clearly visible and contrasting colour on the back or side of the garment.
- 2.3 The Competition Top must be substantially consistent in design and branding across all athletes representing the same Province or Territory.
- 2.4 The Competition Top may be short-sleeved, long-sleeved, or sleeveless, as determined by the PTSO.
- 2.5 The style of the uniform may differ between men's and women's garments, provided the overall design and branding remain consistent.

3. Sponsor Branding

- 3.1 PTSOs may include branding on Competition Tops at their discretion (e.g., affiliated clubs, teams, gyms, commercial partners, or individual athlete sponsors). Individual customization is permitted, provided that the designated logo areas, logo sizes, and maximum number of logos remain consistent across all athletes representing the same Province or Territory. The size, placement, and number of logos shall be determined by the respective PTSO, provided that the Provincial/Territorial identification requirements outlined in this Uniform Code remain clearly visible.

4. Foreign National Participants and Canadian Athletes Living Abroad

- 4.1 Foreign National Participants and Canadian athletes residing abroad who are not affiliated with a PTSO are exempt from the Provincial/Territorial identification requirements of this Uniform Code. They must, however, wear a Competition Top while competing. For the purposes of this Uniform Code, a Competition Top is defined as an outer garment covering the athlete's torso.

5. Compliance

- 5.1 Athletes who do not comply with this Uniform Code may be given a Yellow Card and be required by the Jury President to modify their Competition Top before being permitted to compete.

6. Exemption

- 6.1 Any request for an exemption from this Uniform Code must be submitted in writing to the CEC Executive Director for approval. Requests must be received at least two (2) months prior to the start of the event for which the exemption is sought.

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
