- Quas scramble format, 6 problems unlimited attempts, 2.5 hours
- Hand your sheet to the runner at the problem you wish to climb next. Your name will be called ahead of your turn to climb.
- If you are not ready to climb, we will move on to the next climber

- Semi 5on 5off, finals WC format
- Quotas 20/6
- Check results with judge to make sure it is correct. In the event that it is not, please see the head judge or jury president
- For qualifiers, boulders are single colored, holds of different colors are out of bounds
