- Practice starting order is the same as qualification starting order.
- It is the athlete's responsibility to climb in order. Please make sure you are in the venue and you are ready to climb.
- Hand timing: if the timing system fails that round including previous and after heats should be judged based on hand timing i.e. winner with timing system may lose in hand timing.
- Auto belay will be used in this competition. In case of unforeseen incidents, belayers may belay from the ground, instead.
- There are only 3 junior women, so there will be no final, qualifier times will determine podium.
