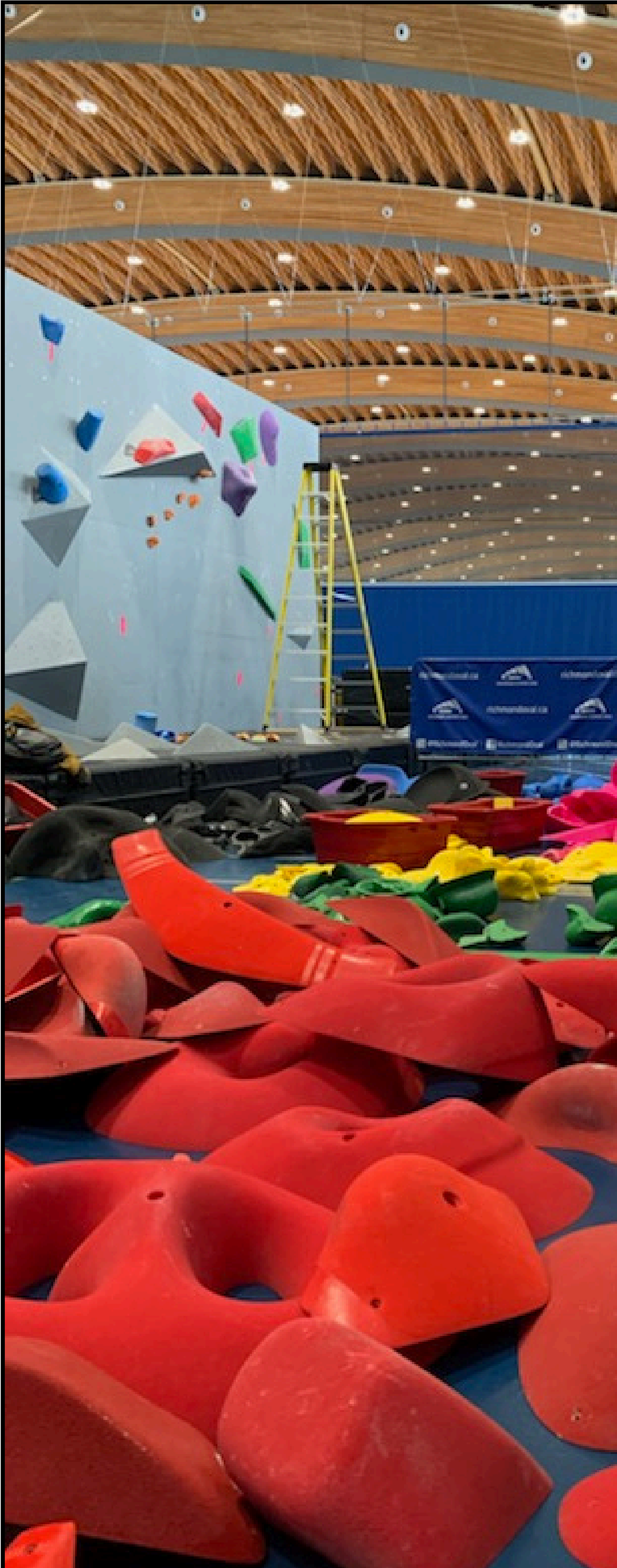


# CEC National Routesetting Pathway Phase 2 - 2025-2026 Season



## PROGRESSION REQUIREMENTS (experience and quality)

### **Level 1 - CEC Apprentice Routesetter**

Must have at least one of the following requirements:

- Has worked three (3) PTSO sanctioned events or higher (local, provincial, out of province)
- Is a former National Team member (Youth or Senior) with at least one (1) Provincial Setting Experience
- Can provide a Letter of Recommendation from a PTSO

### **Level 2 - CEC Routesetter**

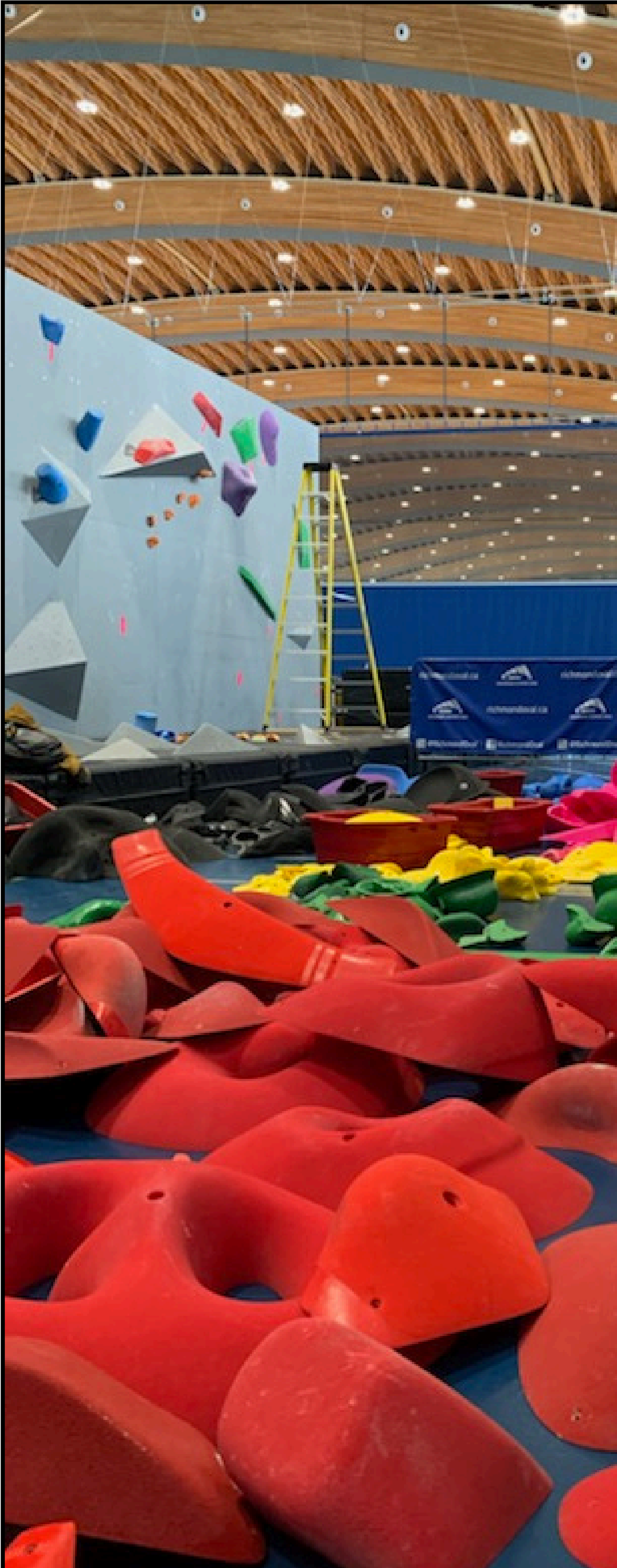
Must have at least one of the following requirements, paired up with a Positive Evaluation from a Level 3 or 4 routesetter:

- Has worked two (2) CEC Nationals or NACS events
- Has worked for three (3) CEC sanctioned events (Regionals, Nationals, NACS)
- Has been Asst./Head Routesetter for one (1) Regional event

## PROGRESSION REQUIREMENTS (experience and quality)

### **Level 3 - CEC Routesetting Leader**

Must have at least one of the following requirements, paired up with a Positive Evaluation from a Level 4 routesetter: Is an IFSC Level 2+ Setter:

- Has Been Asst./Head Routesetter at two (2) CEC Nationals
- Has Been Head Routesetter at two (2) CEC Regionals
- Has worked five (5) CEC Nationals or NACS events
- Is an IFSC Level 1 or 2+

### **Level 4 - CEC Routesetting Evaluator**

Must have at least one of the following requirements, paired up with a Positive Evaluation from a Level 4 routesetter:

- Has been Head Routesetter at three (3) CEC National or NACS events or PanAmerican Championships
