

 - many options available within a 5 minute walk

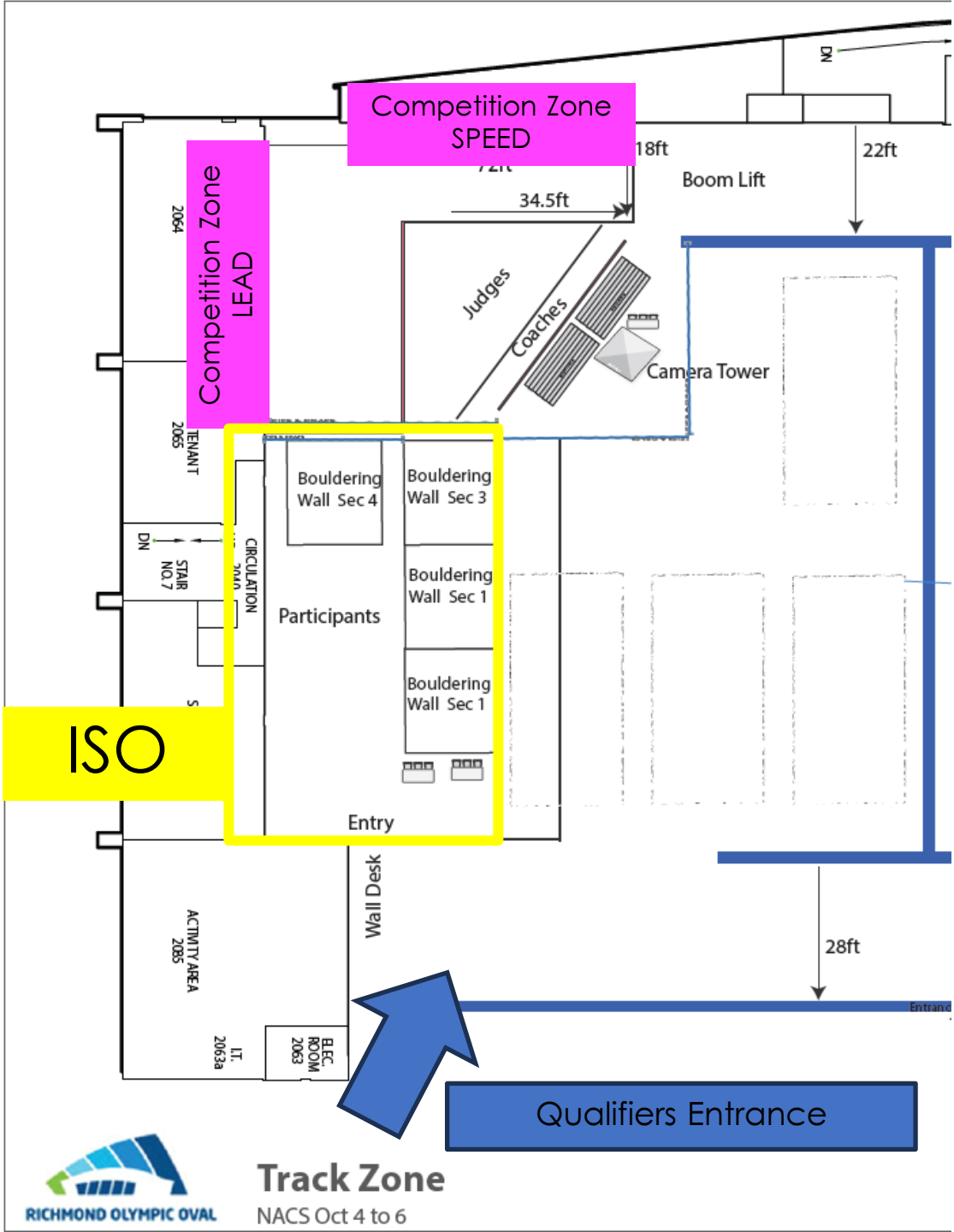


Field of Play LEAD
